Work entered in this show may include all media. Subject matter is open to all types of sports, historical events, hobbies, occupations, etc, related to America's 250 th Anniversary.

Eligibility

Open to any artist 18 and over. Traditional and non-traditional pieces in a variety of media are eligible. A limit of four pieces per artist may be submitted. We will only accept work that has been completed in the last three years and has not previously been on display at the Museum. No work that requires special installation is eligible. No nudity or any pieces deemed controversial or inappropriate by the curators will be allowed entry.

Note: All work must be properly framed and wired. Wires must be taut and secure at a point at least 1/3 down the frame. No saw-tooth hangers. Wrapped edges must be finished.

Entry Fees

There is a non-refundable fee of \$10 each or 4/\$30, payable by cash or check (made out to the Bloomingdale Park District) A maximum of four pieces may be submitted.

Juror

Denise Laurin is an artist, art historian/speaker, and educator. She is a former Adjunct Professor at Illinois Institute of Art in Chicago and Waubensee Community College in Sugar Grove, IL. Also former Art History instructor and art and digital photography instructor at the Beekman School in New York city.

You will be notified by e-mail or phone on Friday, June 12 to pick up any pieces that are not accepted by the juror. The pick-up date for these pieces is Saturday, June 13 from 10am-2pm.



Sales

The Bloomingdale Park District Museum retains a 30 percent commission on all works sold. Payment to the artist is made after the close of the exhibition.

Agreement

By submitting this entry, the artist agrees to the conditions of this prospectus and agrees to the use of images for publicity.

Return of Entries

The exhibition closes on Saturday, July 18 at 4 p.m. Artists must pick up their work either on Saturday July 18, between 4 and 6 p.m., or Monday, July 20 between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. Other arrangements may be made by calling the Museum.

Liability & Insurance

The Bloomingdale Park District will NOT assume responsibility for any damages or loss for any exhibitor's property. All possible care is taken to safeguard works of art. The exhibitor's signature on the prospectus constitutes an agreement to the conditions contained in this prospectus. Failure to accept these conditions results in disqualification from the exhibit. All artists are responsible for carrying their own insurance on their work.

Note

Work must remain for the entire duration of the show. NO early pick-up. Work left 14 days beyond the first pick-up date are considered property of the Museum unless specific arrangements are made.
